- Application is open to all Animal Scientists and Technologists
- Part of the BSAS remit in support of the Animal Industries

Update on Developments Purposes of Accreditation

- Assurance of competence to:
 - Provide for animal's needs
 - Deliver food safety and environmental sustainability
 - Provide high standard of service (in widest sense) to
 - Clients
 - Government
 - Society
 - Colleagues
- Career Development
 - Creating a culture of training and continuous learning
 - Career opportunity widening
- International Recognition

Update on Developments Essential Elements

- Independent Oversight, Audit and Governance at International level (RSB, CSci, Science Council,)
- A Register of current and continuing competence
- Not a member's club, nor an automatic function of job description, position, presumptive deserts or past merit
- Skills and abilities at Professional Science and Technology level (other schemes cover craft and technician level)
- Activities Registered must be verifiable and open to test by peers
- Continuous (and contemporary) Professional Development is an integral requirement

Future Initiatives

- Strengthen credibility, by
 - Numbers
 - Names
 - Reputation / usefulness
 - Difference
- Remain a choice, but become an 'imperative' rather than a 'consideration'
- Improved web-based application, assessment and CPD recording
- Greater involvement in the scheme's developments by other bodies such as Industry, Government and policy-makers
